Friday, 26 May:

- Kafka Museum, Smetana Museum (Old Town), New Town: Wenceslas Square, National Museum, Faust House, Dvorak Museum, and National Theater.
- Jewish Quarter: Museum of Decorative Arts, Old Jewish Cemetery, Old-New Synagogue, St. Agnes's Convent, Jewish Town Hall, Cubist Houses
